Halloween Safety Tips



Small children should not wear masks. Costumes are fine, but use makeup for their faces. Costumes should be bright colored or florescent. Walk on the sidewalk.

Please use caution and do not let small children (under 12 years of age) trick or treat alone. Have at least one child carry a working flashlight.

All Arrowwood Coop Members should turn on their back patio porch lights and lock their patio doors.

Children should trick or treat ro houses with lights on. Please do not disturb neighbors that do not have their lights on. Do not go to a house alone. Go in groups.

Set time limits, i.e., from 6:45pm (sundown) until 8:00pm for example. Have children check in on time.

Children should dress in warm clothes under their costume. If it is raining or snowing, rain gear should be worn.

If possible, an adult or older teenager should go with the children to help the smaller trick or treaters.

Candy should be inspected, either by the Ann Arbor Police Department or by an adult prior to consumption.

All candy not in wrappers should be discarded. Apples should be x-rayed before eating unless you know who gave your child the fruit.

Homemade candy, cookies, and other treats should not be eaten by children, but should be given to the birds.

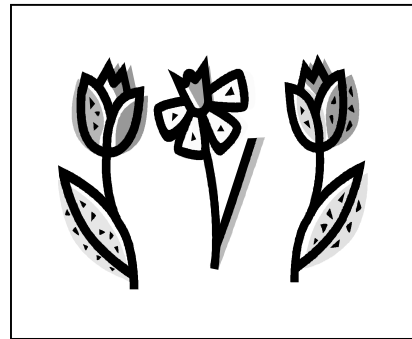
